Can Shed Marion will be open to the public *Thursdays and Fridays from 9:30am-6:00pm and Saturday 8:00am-4:00pm*.

Coming soon we will be opening a location in Hiawatha.

Can Shed is pleased to be partnering with Wilson Avenue Hy-Vee, Johnson Avenue Hy-Vee and 6<sup>th</sup> Street Hy-Vee Drugstore, who have designated to our Can Shed SW Cedar Rapids location as their redemption center of choice, in line with DNR guidelines.

Can Shed is working to become more efficient and to offer our customers more options, we will be installing Reverse Vending Machines in selected locations by the end of the month. We anticipate will be able to accept all Iowa deposit returns by 2<sup>nd</sup> July.
